A Board must provide a standard or local school calendar that complies with the School Calendar Regulation (BC Reg. 114/2002, BC Reg. 166/02) as set out in the School Act (sections 73, 77 and 78).

DEFINITIONS:

In this bylaw,

"standard school calendar"• means the calendar referred to in Schedule 1

"local school calendar " means a proposal of the school board to make available a local school calendar which departs from the standard school calendar established by the Regulation.

"School calendar proposal" means a proposal of the school board to make available a local school calendar which departs from the standard school calendar established by the Regulation, or to amend a school calendar after it has been made available as required by the Act and Regulation.

Words and expressions used in this bylaw have the same meanings as are assigned to them in the Act and Regulation.

APPROVAL:

A school calendar proposal which has been approved by the school board in accordance with the provisions of the bylaw, shall govern school operation in

accordance with its terms.

DISTRIBUTION:

Following approval, a local school calendar, or a school calendar shall be made available to parents of students in the school on or before May 31, as required by the Act.

Following approval of an amendment to a school calendar, the board shall give written notice of the amendment to the school calendar and the date on which they are to take effect to:

- (a) the parents of the students enrolled in the school, and
- (b) the employees of the board assigned to that school and to their unions and other representatives
